#### OUR VISION

Our purpose is to decentralize professional theatre in Minnesota by increasing engagement and opportunity in New Prague and the surrounding area. It is our dream that New Prague will be a known destination for quality performing arts and arts education.

#### **OUR STORY**

DalekoArts was founded in 2012 by theatre artists Ben Thietje and Amanda White as a way to help decentralize professional theatre in Minnesota.

New Prague was chosen as the company's home due to the community's extraordinary interest in theatre, the regional growth and development it has experienced in the last decade, its relative proximity to the Twin Cities, and its close ties to the founders.

"Daleko" — a Czech word meaning "far away" — reflects New Prague's strong bohemian roots, its spatial relationship to the cultural hub that is the Twin Cities, and the ensemble's desire to step back and examine the world from a new point of view.

There were lots of reasons for Daleko to produce this play, but the one that immediately caught my attention was pretty simple: it creeped me out. In my opinion, "scary" is one of the most challenging things to accomplish on stage, and we love a good challenge. Film and TV can do so much with CGI effects, camera positions, etc. For us live theatre folk, it can be a little trickier to produce a monster on stage that doesn't come off a bit...silly. What I liked about The Thin Place was it didn't lean on much more than a good story. I like to think that after ten seasons, we've gotten fairly good at telling those.

But spooky isn't all Mr. Hnath has to offer with The Thin Place. The play also explores a very relevant and unsettling question: how do we know what's real? Our world today is filled with truths and not-quite-untruths, facts and alternative facts. The line of those hoping to guide us through this entanglement is not a short one. Are we seeing reality, or are we seeing what we want to see...what we need to see?

These questions (along with the "scary") have been an immense pleasure to explore — especially with this hugely talented cast, crew, and creative team. I hope you enjoy your time with us tonight, and that this journey through the thin place perfectly delivers you into Spooky Season.




