## Friends,

Happiest and Merriest to you and yours, and welcome back to DalekoArts!

When the original Broadway production of Irving Berlin's White Christmas, based on the 1954 musical film, opened in November of 2008 for a limited run at the Marquis Theater. it was not what anyone would call an intimate affair. The opening night cast of 28 actors played 47 roles; they were supported by four "swings" (a theatre term for an actor who learns multiple roles and only goes on if someone in the cast is unable to perform) and 10 understudies in their ranks. There were 27 musicians creating the sweeping sounds of a full Broadway pit orchestra. There was an astonishing support system in place for the performers: in truly dramatic fashion, there were two separate companies devoted solely to designing and maintaining actor wigs. There were hundreds of costumes. The scenic design contained 12 unique locations in multiple US states. The average ticket price was just under \$100. That production closed in January of 2009.

Fourteen years later, almost to the date, this production (the one you've come to see) opened at the Prague Theater in New Prague, Minnesota. It is, by design, what everyone would call an intimate affair.

We have cut the cast down to 13 actors, including one little 8-year-old girl who is making her theatrical debut. (Full disclosure: that little girl is my niece, Evie, and I'm the one in the back of the House just busting at the seams with uncontrollable pride. She's nothing short of luminous. And that's just on the playground. Wait 'til you hear her sing.) These 13 glorious artists are singing, dancing, and also playing those 47 characters, some doubling, tripling, and quadrupling roles. They are supported by a pit of only five gifted musicians who are rounding out one of the more complex musical scores I've heard. Listen carefully

and you might just hear someone singing in the chorus from backstage while they're running by for a costume change. Three design themes kept popping up as we built the show: 1) this story has both a cinematic legacy and style, 2) beautiful holiday greeting cards and postcards were a staple of the Christmas season in the 1940s and 50s, and 3) we think almost any story can be told simply with the right creative energy. So Scenic Designer Robin used almost entirely repurposed or recycled materials for the build, as is his way. The 12 unique locations in this production are shaped by screen projections and six wooden boxes. (We decided to get wild and use boxes of different sizes.) There are also some box facings, to build a dimensional holiday card feel to some of the created space. The barn wood you see framing the stage was acquired from...an old barn. Average ticket price 14 years later: around \$18.

DalekoArts is a professional theatre company rooted in community placemaking. We believe that we are nothing without the context of our neighbors, our audience, those people who believe in us and who are the inspiration for our work. We strive to create theatre that is accessible for our community, responsible to the world they live in, and designed to speak clearly to their humanity. We want our audience to feel lifted up by the stories we tell. That's what I think White Christmas is about, at its core: the importance of being there for those you love, in ways that honor them...the divine urge we humans have to be of service to those who inspire sacrifice, trust, love, and joy in us. That, and it's also just so much fun.

From all of us at DalekoArts, wishing you the warmest and most peaceful of holiday seasons, surrounded by those worthy loved ones. Now don't forget to sing along!

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
